ARTICLE V - Tax

In addition to all other taxes and fees of any kind now imposed or hereafter imposed by law, there is hereby imposed and levied by the County of Wythe on each person at the rate of Four Percent (4%) of the gross amount paid for food and beverages purchased from any food establishment, whether prepared in such food establishment or not, and whether consumed on the premises or not.

ADD:

ARTICLE V - Tax

- In addition to all other taxes and fees of any kind now imposed or hereafter imposed by law, there is hereby imposed and levied by the County of Wythe on each person at the rate of Six Percent (6%) of the gross amount paid for food and beverages purchased from any food establishment, whether prepared in such food establishment or not, and whether consumed on the premises or not.
 - (A) The Board of Supervisors shall commit one-third (33.3%) of the total receipts from the tax on food and beverages to the Emergency Services and/or Water Department budget.
